Boyd's Air Force career and experience as a fighter pilot underpins all, but his beginning as a military and competitive strategist, the basis for "A Discourse on Winning and Losing" and his ultimate legacy in history all launch from the 1976 publication of the paper "Destruction and Creation." This abstract treatise describes how an interplay of analysis and synthesis destroys and creates our mental images of the external world - disorder turns into order which turns into disorder in a never ending cycle.
